

Year 9 ICT

From September 2007 Year 9 are given the opportunity of doing an ICT GCSE which will be submitted in May 2008. This course is called DiDA [Diploma in Digital Applications] and is worth 4 GCSE.

There are two levels and we will be doing level one which is worth C – A*

It is made up of four units which are each worth one GCSE.

These are:

- AiDA [Using ICT] – Compulsory which they will be doing in year 9
- CiDA [Using ICT]
- Graphics
- ICT in Enterprise

The units are called Summative Project Briefs [SPB]
